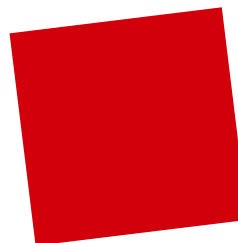

Albert Jacka and William Newton Memorial Scholarships

Scholarship details

- Sponsored by Port Phillip City Council
- Valued at \$1,000
- Available for one year
- One scholarship awarded each year

Who can apply?

- Students completing **Year 8** in a Victorian school in 2015
- **Only students** who live in the **City of Port Phillip**
- Students involved in school and community activities

What documentation you need to provide?

- Applicant's 2015 academic results
- Statements confirming the applicant's involvement in school and community activities
- Evidence of the applicant being in receipt of Youth Allowance, or the applicant's parent/guardian holding a Health Care Card, a Low Income Health Care Card or a Pensioner Concession Card (Centrelink Reference Number required).

Alexander Rushall Scholarships

Scholarship details

- Sponsored by Trust Company Limited
- Valued at \$1,500
- Available for one year
- Eleven scholarships awarded in 2015/16

Who can apply?

- Students who are completing Year 12 in 2015 in a Victorian government school and will commence full-time university in 2016
- Students involved in school and community activities
- Students or their families if they are a dependent, who demonstrate financial need.

What documentation you need to provide?

- Applicant's 2015 academic results as evidence that VCE was completed in a Victorian government school
- Applicant's confirmation of enrolment in an approved tertiary course – evidence will be required by 2 March 2016
- Statement confirming the applicant's involvement in school and community activities
- Evidence of the applicant receiving Youth Allowance or the applicant's parent/guardian holding a Health Care Card, a Low Income Health Care Card or a Pensioner Concession Card (Centrelink Reference Number required).

Alice Jennings Scholarship

Scholarship details

- Sponsored by the Department of Education
- Valued at \$1,000 per year
- Available for the duration of the course/degree, subject to satisfactory academic progress
- One scholarship awarded each year

Who can apply?

- Female Koorie students completing Year 12 in 2015 in a Victorian school

- Students commencing a full-time approved TAFE or university course/degree in 2016 in a field that contributes to the welfare of the Koorie population (eg law, social work, education, psychology or applied science – health, nursing etc.)
- Students involved in Koorie community activities



What documentation you need to provide?

- Applicant's 2015 academic results
- Applicant's confirmation of enrolment in an approved TAFE or university course/degree – evidence will be required by 2 March 2016
- Statement confirming the applicant's involvement in Koorie community activities.

R M Ansett Trust Scholarships

Scholarship details

- Funded by the R M Ansett Trust Fund

- Available for three years (Year 10 through to Year 12) subject to satisfactory academic progress and completion of secondary school in a Victorian government school
- Ten scholarships awarded each year.

Who can apply?

- Students completing Year 9 in 2015 in a Victorian government school who are intending to complete their VCE in 2016 and 2017 in a Victorian government school
- Families or students who demonstrate financial need.

What documentation you need to provide?

- Applicant's 2015 academic results
- Evidence of the applicant receiving Youth Allowance, or the applicant's parent/guardian holding a Health Care Card, a Low Income Health Care Card or a Pensioner Concession Card (Centrelink Reference number required).

- Martha McKay – nee Dammery was born in Windsor on 2 March, 1880, as the second daughter and youngest of the five children of Edward Dammery and Eliza Jane Barr.
- Martha's brother, Thomas Dammery was a school teacher, headmaster and regional inspector of schools around Ballarat. He was a firm believer in state education.

- It is believed that her mother's illiteracy and advocacy of education, and her brother's role as a teacher, led Martha to leave her money to create the Dammary Educational Trust Fund for those who might otherwise not have the opportunity for continued education.

- The money is paid to the **student's school for essential educational items** for which parents are normally expected to pay or pay the school to provide. These essential items do not include voluntary contributions.
- At the end of the year, if there is a remaining balance, it is paid to the parent/guardian for the benefit of the student.
