The College has invested in AVID training for our teachers who use strategies in every subject school wide to teach the students specific skills in reading, writing, inquiry, collaboration and organisation. In addition, students may apply for the AVID elective which prepares students for further study in VCE and tertiary education. Statistics collected over the last 30 years in the USA show that AVID students have triple the success rate of getting into and completing university, compared to non-AVID students. The College enjoys a partnership with Victoria University which provides the College with several university students who attend the AVID elective classes each week to run tutorial sessions.

AVID educators are highly skilled professionals. The specialised training provides teachers with a collection of strategies and tactics to build their students' abilities and aspirations.
