Upgrade and modernisation

Construction update

The construction of Victoria University Secondary College's Cairnlea Campus began in August 2020. The Victorian School Building Authority (VSBA) is working with the school and the broader community to ensure this exciting upgrade reflects the diverse educational needs of current and future students. The works are expected to be complete towards the end of 2021, ready for the 2022 school year.

- Term 3, 2021 STEAM building completed
Performing arts and hospitality building completed
- Term 4, 2021 Learning village completed
- Term 1, 2022 **Stage 1 buildings for Years 10, 11 and 12 completed**

State-of-the-art facilities

In its 2019-2020 State Budget, the Victorian Government committed more than \$23 million for the upgrade and modernisation of VUSC, a state co-educational Year 7–12 college with enrolments of 1,250.

The project will provide local students with safe and nurturing state-of-the-art education facilities.



Performing arts and hospitality

We are creating a performing arts and hospitality building that will incorporate a theatre, music rooms, food technology facilities and a canteen/cafe.



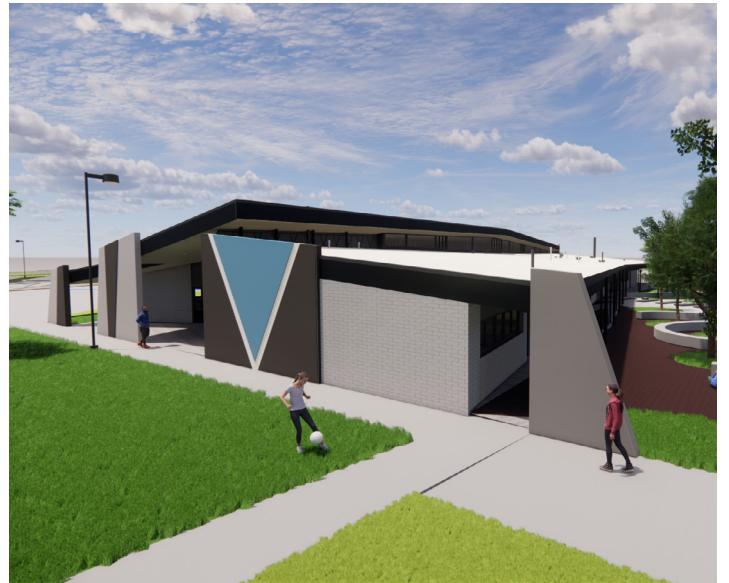
STEAM centre

A new learning village will incorporate modern classrooms with a central library, and the school upgrade will include sports fields and new hard courts.
